## DR. JAGDISH RAI PRESENTS KEYNOTE AT IEG FALL CONFERENCE

Dr. Jagdish Rai, Vice Chancellor, Invertis University, Bareilly, U.P., India delivered the **Conference Keynote: Some Aspects of Quality Issues in Higher Education** on October 16, 2015.

Vice Chancellor Rai, former professor and head, Physics Department, IIT Roorkee, spoke on the concern for continuous improvement and the application of new technology, innovation, and creativity to discipline study.

The need exists, he finds, for entrepreneurial, value-added quality; thus, the importance of class lectures, student assignments, discussion with students, performance of experiments in the lab, summer learning/training, a desired goal being *endurance*.
